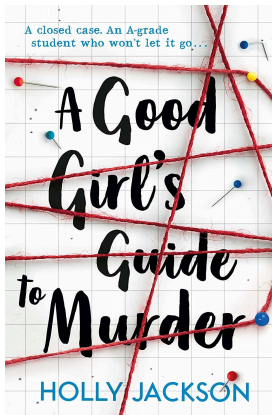


Library New Acquisitions - *A Good Girl's Guide to Murder* Series now available for lending!

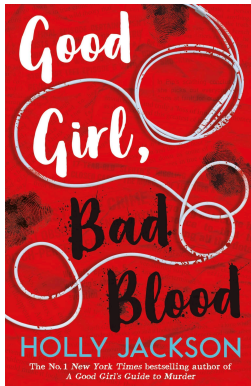

A gripping, twist-filled mystery that will keep you guessing until the very end. Perfect for fans of *One of Us Is Lying* and *Riverdale*.



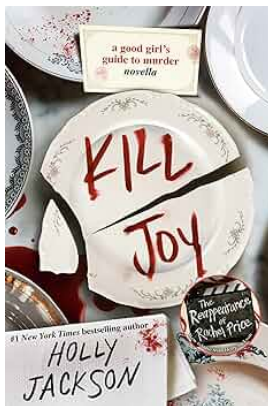
Good Girl, Bad Blood by Holly Jackson
